- The outcomes and guiding questions were also be presented at the Canadian Communication Association conference (Ryerson University, May 30 - June 2).

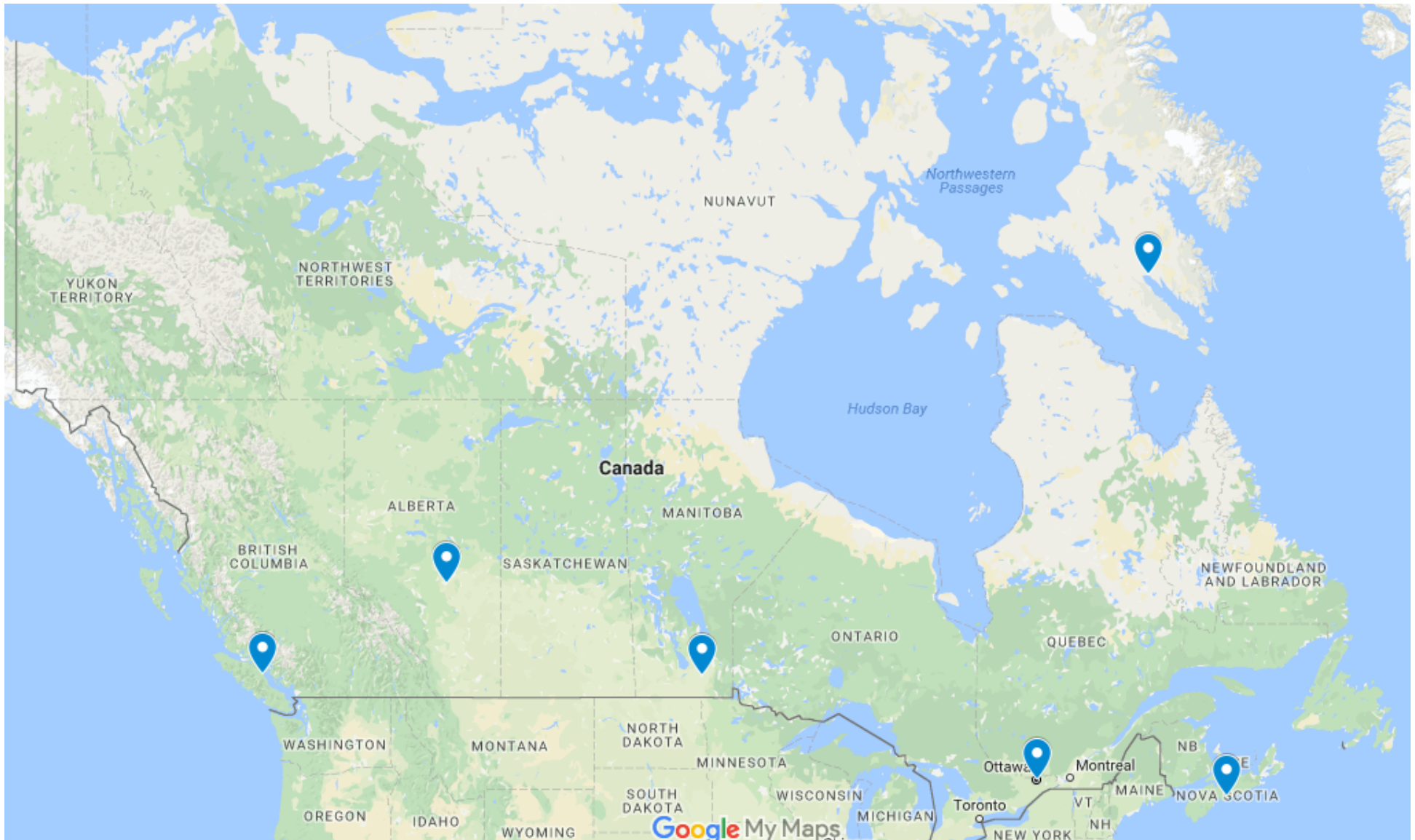
National event Ottawa - June 15-17, 2017 / Evento nacional Ottawa - 15 al 17 de junio de 2017

- Outcomes include live broadcasting, audio & twitter archives, and media coverage;
- For the national event, archived notes will be produced from 40 presentations;
- 3-hour forum on regional event outcomes, *1991 Broadcasting Act*, CRTC policy and process took place to develop terms of reference and draft policy for preparing an intervention for the upcoming policy review.

- Comments on draft outcomes and policy briefs from Indigenous Broadcasters due September 1, 2017;

- Journal articles will be submitted to *Canadian Journal of Communication* and open access platforms;
- Submit an intervention for the upcoming Native Broadcasting Policy (CRTC 1990-89) review scheduled for 2018 in the most recent CRTC Three Year Plan 2017-2020;
- Submit comments for proposed review of the *1991 Broadcasting Act*.

Key Policy & Process Themes

Principales políticas y procesos

1. The need for suitable and sustainable resources for Indigenous stations and broadcasters.
La necesidad de recursos adecuados y sostenibles para las estaciones y organismos de radiodifusión indígenas.
2. The need for investment in training, especially for young people to engage in broadcasting.
La necesidad de invertir en la formación, especialmente para los jóvenes a participar en la radiodifusión.
3. Content quotas for Indigenous music and language programming.
Cuotas de contenido para la programación de música y lenguaje indígena.
4. Need to conduct meaningful consultation with communities before, during, and after the policy review process.
Necesidad de llevar a cabo una consulta significativa con las comunidades antes, durante y después del proceso de revisión de políticas.
5. Importance of engaging and including youth.
Importancia de involucrar e incluir a los jóvenes.
6. Need for Indigenous representation at the CRTC.
Necesidad de representación indígena en la CRTC.
7. The policy must be flexible and keep-up with new technological innovations.
La política debe ser flexible y mantenerse al día con las nuevas innovaciones tecnológicas.
8. Policy must center sovereignty of Indigenous nations.
La política debe centrar la soberanía de las naciones indígenas.

Les Carpenter (Native Communications Society of the NWT):

"It is in a number of different ways. I met members from Wawatay Communication Society. I have been in Yellowknife (Northwest Territories) for how long? I was in Whitehorse (Yukon) since 2000. When you don't get together, you don't get to exchange ideas and talk over issues ... So something like this should be organized ... at least once a year we should try to get together."
