EDMONTON (ALBERTA), APRIL 13, 2017 /PRESS RELEASE/ – This year - the second in the CRTC's Three Year Plan (2016-2019) - the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission plans to review the Native Broadcasting Policy (CRTC 1990-89). The gatherings entitled "The Future of First Nations, Inuit and Métis Broadcasting: Conversation and Convergence" aim to bring practitioners, policy makers and academics together as allies and to prepare a context for respectful and meaningful consultations. Regional events will be held from February to May culminating in a national conference hosted in Ottawa from June 15-17.

The third event will take place in Edmonton, Alberta - April 21, 2017, at the Telus Center (University of Alberta, 11104 87 Ave NW).

Presenters in Edmonton will include:

Sessions will also focus on the CRTC Native Broadcasting Policy¹ and the process for the upcoming policy review. Participants are invited to comment on the following questions:

- How would you like the CRTC consultation process to be conducted?
- How should the review process itself be changed?
- What should the policy entail?
- What are the elements to include or exclude?
- What changes would be required to the *Broadcasting Act, 1991*, to ensure the policy is upheld?
